### DUTIES / RESPONSIBILITIES

AND RESPONSIBILITIES: 1. Responsible for the direct, day-to-day supervision of the chapter and act as liaison between faculty, administration, students, and community. 2. Develops a budget and an outline of activities for the principal's approval. 3. Processes induction information and coordinates the induction ceremony (e.g., notifies the principal, updates permanent records, sends paperwork to the National Honor Society headquarters, etc.). 4. Review each member for compliance with Society standards and obligations. Send letters to students and their parents or guardians regarding membership requirements, probation status, and termination. 5. Supervises the election and installation of National Honor Society officers. 6. Supervises approved fund raising projects. 7. Duties may require working extended hours and/or weekends.
